Virtual Internships An Overview

Our 12 week virtual internships provide UK University Students with the opportunity to tackle various international development issues and achieve real outcomes for our partners in Sri Lanka.

Our course specific internships take place remotely, with students working independently on research projects set by the Travelteer team - all you need is a computer, phone and internet connection.

Each student is paired with a Travelteer mentor that will guide them through the research process with regular contact via video conferencing. In addition to their research project, students will also help the Travelteer team create and implement online marketing campaigns and write informative blog posts showcasing aspects of their given research projects.



Volunteer Programme: Marine & Wildlife Conservation

Our Marine & Wildlife Conservation programme works closely with the Sri Lankan Environmental Department and various local NGOs. These partnerships have led to the creation of various high impact Conservation projects on Sri Lanka's South Coast and provide UK volunteers with the chance to contribute to sustainable development.

Our projects aim to regenerate key areas of indigenous rainforest, boost sea turtle hatchling numbers and implement effective recycling strategies for ocean plastic. Marine & Wildlife volunteers will assist the Travelteer Conservation team by developing various research proposals that will help refine our projects and increase the their impact on the local environment.

Volunteer Programme: English Development

Our English Development programme works closely with a number of Sri Lankan schools to create sustainable projects that provide brighter futures for children in rural communities.

Many rural school children can understand and speak basic words in English, however their comprehension and conversational skills are underdeveloped and the importance of English cannot be understated for an island nation so heavily reliant on tourism and remittance (Sri Lankans working abroad and sending money back to their families).

Through the creation of research proposals in the UK, English Development volunteers gain invaluable experience in an international education system, providing global perspective and insight into childhood development in different educational settings.

Volunteer Programme: Textiles & Design

Our Textiles & Design programme works in partnership with local communities to provide textiles training for disadvantaged women in rural areas of Sri Lanka. Our team is currently implementing a 360° strategy for recycling ocean plastics, designing and producing sustainable products under our 'Palm Project' brand and then marketing them online through social media campaigns and online selling platforms.

Within Sri Lanka, our programme teaches disadvantaged local women income generating skills, helping them to become more self sufficient. The products designed by both volunteers and local women are subsequently sold online and at various local boutiques with all proceeds going back into the community!





Design & Textiles Virtual Internships (12 Weeks) 6 - 8 Hours Per Week

We're looking for students to help refine our Sri Lankan Textiles programme with an emphasis on sustainability. Under the guidance of their mentor, Design & Textiles volunteers will undertake a specific research topic provided by the Travelteer team. The research project should be formally written up and will be presented to Travelteer management upon completion.

Travelteer mentors will be on hand to help guide volunteers through this research project and volunteers will also engage in various marketing and fundraising assignments for the Travelteer team.

Volunteer Programme: Sports Development

Our Sports Development programme works closely with a number of Sri Lankan schools to implement sports coaching at the grassroots level - unlocking the potential of disadvantaged children in rural areas by providing skilled volunteer coaches and funding for both equipment and facilities.

The programme provides hands-on experience for Sports Development volunteers to plan and implement their own sport sessions in a developing country. Our various projects focus on inclusivity and skill learning to promote health and wellbeing through the coaching of different sports.

Volunteer Fundraising

Volunteer fundraising has already made a huge impact on the lives of disadvantaged communities in Sri Lanka. To date, we have raised over £120,000 that has gone towards new teaching and sports facilities at rural schools, meal provision in disadvantaged communities, improved equipment for conservation efforts and more!

We encourage all of our volunteers to fundraise for their programme of choice. Over the course of our 12 week virtual internships we usually recommend each volunteer to try and fundraise £300 - it is not a necessity but any money that can be raised makes an impact on our Sri Lankan projects.

From setting up your JustGiving page to advice on great fundraising activities, the Travelteer team is always here to help!



Personal Mentorship

Throughout the 12 week virtual internship, each volunteer will be matched with a mentor from our Travelteer staff. As a virtual internship, communication will be done remotely through online video calls - our friendly team are always help and mentors will support volunteers through all aspects of the research project.

Virtual Internship Fees

Our 12 week virtual internships cost £300 per person. Students should make sure to check whether they are eligible for a grant from their university to cover this cost! Should students undertaking our 12 month virtual internship wish to join the Travelteer team on the ground in Sri Lanka, they will receive £300 in credit towards their living costs in-country.

Submit Your CV & Cover Letter

If you would like to get involved in one of our virtual internships, kick-off your application by emailing through both your CV and a Cover Letter to our team at team@travelteer.co.uk. Make sure to use your cover letter as a chance to tell us which programme you are most interested in and why you believe you would be a strong candidate for this remote 12 week internship.

Travelteer UK management will individually assess each CV & cover letter to shortlist applicants heading onto the next stage of interviews.

Phone Interview

Shortlisted applicants will be contacted via email and a phone interview will be scheduled.

The phone interview will be conducted by a member of the Travelteer UK Team and gives us the chance to get to know our applicants a little better and understand more about their interests and experience.

Upon completion of all phone interviews, our team will notify candidates on whether they will proceed to the final step of internship application process to be conducted by Travelteer Management.

Online Interview

The final stage of the application process will be a online video interview with Travelteer Management.

This final stage gives applicants a chance to discuss possible research topics with Travelteer management ahead of starting their 12 week virtual internship..


Upon completion of all video interviews, successful applicants will be matched with a Travelteer Mentor who will guide them through all aspects of the placement.


