UNIVERSITY OF YORK ORDINANCES FRAMEWORK – 'CURRENT' TO 'PROPOSED' FRAMEWORK

There are 11 existing University <u>Ordinances</u>. The new framework proposes 20, to: (a) reflect the reduction in the content of the Charter and Statutes and the need to migrate material from them to the level of Ordinances and (b) to create new Ordinances where there were gaps in provisions which should already have been in place, eg a set of Standing Orders.
