Workshop on Sample Size Calculation — Monday 26th September 2011

Workshop

This is a half day workshop on sample size calculations, presented by Professor Martin Bland. He will introduce power calculations for two group trials, discuss some limitations, and describe an alternative approach using confidence intervals. He will discuss the special problems of sample size for cluster randomised trials and for pilot and exploratory studies. This will be followed by a question and answer surgery chaired by Dr Karen Bloor, where participants can put any questions about trial design to Professor David Torgerson, Dr. Gerry Richardson and Professor Martin Bland.

The workshop will be held in the Auditorium of the ARRC Building. The workshop will start at 1.00 pm and will finish at 6.00 pm. A buffet lunch will be available from 12.00 noon.

Main Conference — Tuesday 27th September, Wednesday 28th September 2011

The Conference will open on Tuesday 27th September and close on Wednesday 28th September. The registration fee includes lunch and refreshments on both days. The conference dinner will be held on Tuesday evening.
