Parish register transcripts (also known as bishops' transcripts) are contemporary copies of the parish registers made by the incumbent or his clerk and sent to the diocesan authorities, sometimes at Easter, and sometimes during the visitation process. In theory the transcripts ought to contain the same information as the registers, but in practice there may be considerable differences between the two – one might contain entries that are not in the other, or one may give more detail than the other. If there is any doubt about a register entry, or the register appears incomplete, the transcripts are always worth consulting. Similarly, if there is a problem with the transcripts, the original registers should be checked.

Parish register transcripts in most dioceses exist from the 16th century onwards, but the first general obligation to compile them dates from the Provincial Constitution of Canterbury in 1597. There was a general break in the registers during the Commonwealth period (1649-1660). Some dioceses, however, tried to make good this gap after the Restoration by ordering retrospective transcription. The need for transcripts was greatly reduced by the introduction of Civil Registration in 1837, although baptisms and burials often continue up to about 1850, and occasionally later.

The transcripts for the diocese of York are held by the Borthwick Institute, with the exception of those covering the former archdeaconry of Nottingham which are deposited at Southwell Minster Library. Microfilms of these transcripts can be seen in the Nottinghamshire County Record Office.

There are also a number of other repositories holding Yorkshire parish register transcripts. Transcripts of parishes in the peculiar jurisdictions of Crayke before 1837 and Northallertonshire before 1813 are held at the Durham University Library, Archives and Special Collections. Northallertonshire parishes include: Birkby, Brompton, Cowesby, Deighton, Hutton Bonville, Kirby Sigston, Leake, Northallerton with Romanby, Osmotherley, North Otterington, West Rounton, Nether Siltan, Thornton-le-Street and High Worsall. In 1541 the archdeaconry of Richmond, containing parts of the North and West Ridings was detached from the diocese of York and given to the newly founded see of Chester. The transcripts for this area, and those for the diocese of Ripon after 1836, are held by the West Yorkshire Archives Service in Leeds.

The survival of transcripts for the first half of the seventeenth century is extremely patchy, with generally only a few years surviving from each parish. During the period of the Civil War and the Commonwealth, from about 1643 and 1660, there were none returned for Yorkshire at all. After the Restoration the series of transcripts is almost complete for most parishes up to 1837, with baptisms and burials being recorded up to around 1850.

Parish register transcripts in the Institute are all available on microfilm. This is to protect the originals from wear and tear. The following list has been designed to provide researchers with a basic list of all the parishes whose parish register transcripts are held by the Borthwick Institute. The Borthwick Institute holds these transcripts for over 800 parishes, and as the holdings are at times very patchy it is strongly advised that researchers contact the Institute in advance either by phoning the searchroom on (01904) 321166 or emailing bihr500@york.ac.uk, to check that we hold the dates required.
