This bibliography contains all works referred to in the text (except in a small number of minor cases, where details can be found in other works referred to in the same context), by either year of publication or abbreviation, as indicated below in parentheses immediately after the name(s). Included is a full list, arranged chronologically, of all Frege's works published in English, though only those pieces referred to in the text are specifically picked out from the collections in which they are contained. Unless otherwise indicated, references given in the text are to the relevant publication (edition, collection or translation) *first* named in the bibliography. Where the reference is solely to the original German edition of a work, or the reference to an English translation is omitted (as in the case of Frege's *Begriffsschrift*, *Grundlagen* and *Grundgesetze*, in particular), any translations are my own (in the latter case, the translations are taken from my forthcoming *Frege Reader*).
