Each paper is allocated an hour, made up of a short presentation by the authors, followed by a response from a nominated discussant and a general discussion. Presentations by [doctoral students and junior researchers](#) are encouraged. The number of participants will be limited to around 50. Workshop participants will be expected to attend the whole of the meeting and play a role as either author, discussant or chairperson.

The event will begin on the evening of 5th September and finish on the morning of 8th September and includes three nights accommodation.
