

Figure 2. Tentative stages of landscape evolution around the cairn site (vertical scale exaggerated).

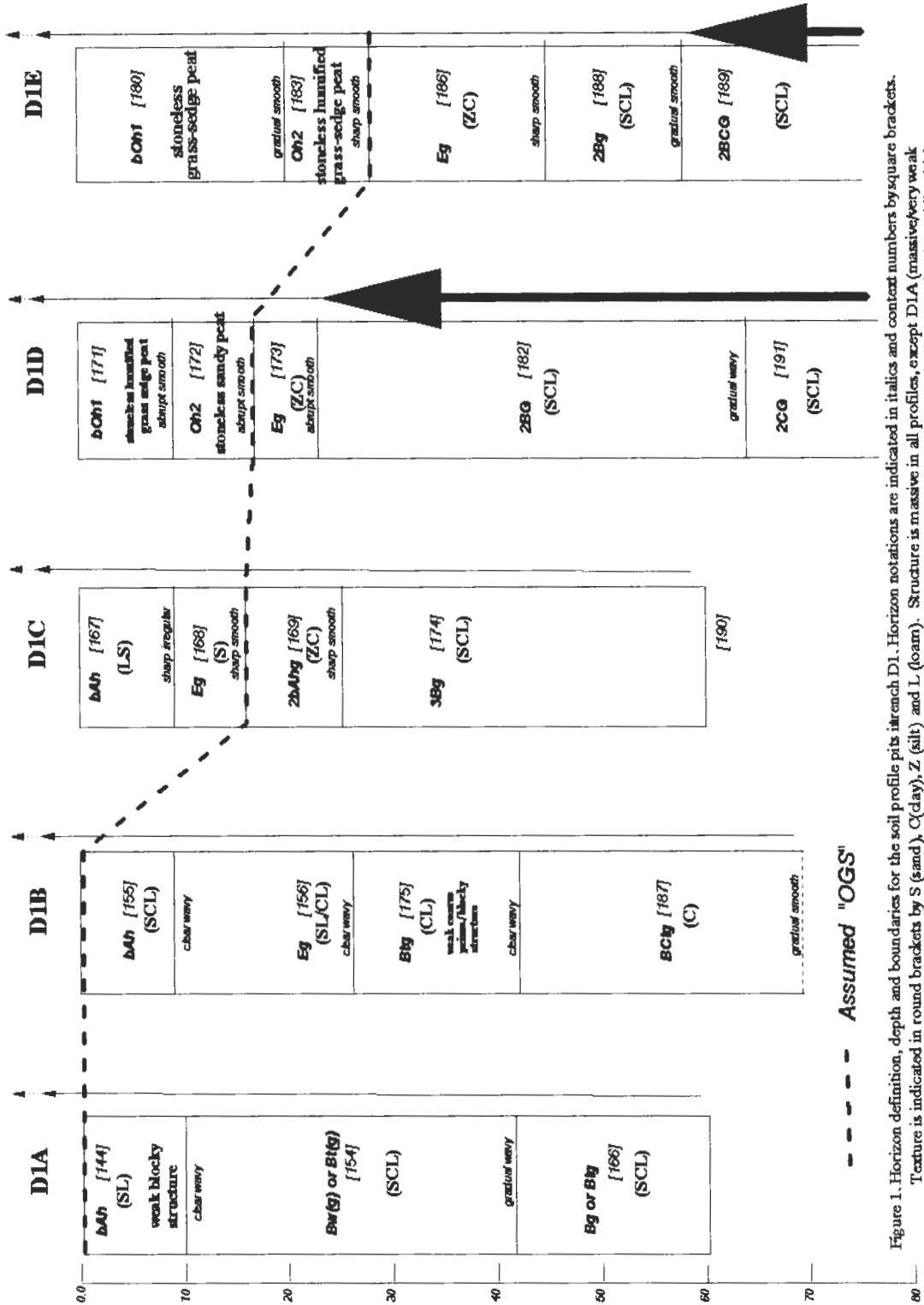


Figure 1. Horizon definition, depth and boundaries for the soil profile pits in trench D1. Horizon notations are indicated in italics and content numbers by square brackets. Texture is indicated in round brackets by S (sand), C (clay), Z (silt) and L (loam). Structure is massive in all profiles, except D1A (massive/very weak medium subangular in bAh) and D1B (weak coarse blocky to prismatic in Eg). Thin arrows indicate the depth of periodical waterlogging, whilst thick arrows indicate the depth of permanent waterlogging. Dotted arrows indicate variable depths above the lower boundary of the sand dune layers.
