1578 Christ Church District Church, Meadow Lane. Consecrated 1826 as an additional Church. Erected by parliamentary grant, £12,000; land bought by Subscription; Total £12000. Endowment OPE £22.15.0 Pew Rents £55 All other categories none. Sittings Free 620 Other 980. On 30 March Morning GC 180 SS 138 Afternoon GC 25 SS 40 Evening GC 370. Remarks The District of Christ Church contains a dense population of the working classes, chiefly very poor. A small portion only of the Sunday Scholars attend ye afternoon service. Signed Jno. 1579 (Church of Jesus Christ of) Latter Day Saints Meeting Room, South Market. Not erected for public worship. ExW. Sittings Free 240 Free Space 200. On 30 March No Scholars; Morning GC 100 Afternoon GC 150 Evening GC 200 Average during 6 months nearly the same as above stated. 1580 Wesley(an Methodist Chapel), Meadow Lane. Erected 1815. SEB ExW. Sittings Free 508 Other 1048. On 30 March Morning GC 526 SS 230 Afternoon GC 400 Evening GC 640. Average during 12 months GC 1040 (average of morning and evening) SS 220. The afternoon service was a society meeting the average number is not more than 100. 1581 Meeting House of the Society of Friends, Camp Lane Court, Water Lane Erected Rebuilt before 1800. SEB ExW. Space Floor 2904 sq ft Galleries 1548 sq ft Estimated Seating Floor 650 Galleries 450. On 30 March Morning 363 Afternoon 169 Evening No Meeting. Remarks We have another meeting house under the same roof used regularly for public worship on week days (capacity as below): Ground floor area 1452 sq ft Will accommodate 300, Gallery floor area 940 sq ft Will accommodate 200. 1582 Salem (Independent) Chapel, Hunslet Lane. Erected before 1800. SEB ExW. *Sittings* Free 138 [+] 200 for the Sunday Scholars; Other 762. On 30 March Morning GC 341 SS 160 Afternoon X Evening GC 369 SS 51. *Average* Morning GC 420 SS 180 Afternoon X Evening GC 450 SS 31. *Remarks* Great prevailing sickness has for three or four Sundays made the congregation and Sunday School much thinner in attendance. We have a Sunday School in addition to the one entered, about a mile from us. They attend the chapel once a month. The other Sundays we have a special religious service for them in addition to the Sunday School. Signed Rev. William Hudswell, Minister, Leeds. [501/6]

KIRKGATE WARD (Population 3337)

1583 St Peter, the Parish Church of Leeds. Consecrated 1841 in lieu of the old Parish Church which was pulled down. Cost By private subscription, Total £35,000. *Endowment* see my return to the Income Tax. *Sittings* Free 1800 Other 650. On 30 March Morning GC 1800 SS 344 Afternoon GC 350 SS 370 Evening GC 2800 SS none. *Average* Morning GC 1800 SS 350 Afternoon GC 500 SS 370 Evening GC 2800 SS none. *Remarks* The numbers here given have been supplied by the Churchwardens who state that at the Evening Service there are many who are obliged to stand during the whole Service, while many are obliged to go away, not having Standing Room. Hence the number of attendants is greater than the number of sittings. Signed W.F. Hook, Vicar of Leeds. [501/7]

1584 Call Lane (General Baptist) Chapel. Erected 1691. SEB ExW. *Sittings* Free 100 Other 400 Free Space none. On 30 March Morning GC 169 Afternoon GC X SS X Evening 177 GC X SS X. *Average during 8 months* Morning GC 170 Afternoon GC X SS X Evening GC 220. *Remarks* The present congregation has only occupied the chapel since July last. 1585 Rational Progressionists (Atheists and Deists). Erected since 1800. A Room adjoining other premises, used for different things. *Sittings* 12 by 9 all free Free Space 450. On 30 March Morning GC X Afternoon GC X SS 14 Evening GC 300. *Average during 12 months* from 2 to 300. *Remarks* In this Room there is a Mutual Improvement Society we also have Temperance Lectures. 1586 Old Rotation Office (Israelites), Kirgate. Erected before 1800. Separate room. ExW. *Sittings* 10yds by 7, 70 seats all free. On 30 March Morning GC 11 Afternoon GC 70. Signed Matthew Shaw, Preacher, Crescent Street No 4, Leeds. [501/10]
