

Directions to CHE and the University

By car:

Visitors to the University must park in the designated campus pay and display car parks only. The nearest pay and display car park to CHE is '**Campus North**' (see the map on page 1). CHE is a short walk from there, with the route signposted and fully wheelchair accessible. Next nearest is the '**Campus Central**' car park (see map). If arriving after 9.00am parking can be difficult in these car parks, so a generally less busy alternative is the '**Campus South**' car park located off Heslington Lane (a 10-15 minute walk to CHE). By taxi:

There is a taxi rank just outside York railway station, and the journey from there to CHE takes around 20 minutes, costing around £8.00 one-way. Ask the driver to drop you at the taxi drop-off point outside the HYMS (Hull York Medical School) building, Campus North car park.

It can often be as quick, and cheaper, to take a bus, and the bus stop going to the University is also located outside the main York railway station entrance.

By bus:

There are buses from the York railway station and York city centre to the University approximately every 10 minutes during the day, taking around 20 minutes to reach the University campus. From opposite York railway station, catch the **FirstYork No. 66** bus to the University and get off at the J B Morrell library (see the map on page 1):

From the bus stop, turn right and then first left to walk up the steps leading from the roadside. Turn right at the top of the steps, cross the footbridge, turn left, and ahead you will see a narrow set of concrete steps to the left side of the building in front of you. Go up the steps and at the top turn right and follow a pathway which leads down into a courtyard. The building to the left of you is Alcuin A Block and CHE, so turn left at the bottom of the pathway and go through the external door into Alcuin A Block. Turn left up the first flight of stairs and straight ahead is a door leading into CHE and its Reception. Press the doorbell on the wall to your right for attention.

NB: Both these sets of steps are quite steep. If you would like directions to CHE avoiding stairs please contact CHE Reception at the number below.
