You need to have a degree in economics or another quantitative subject. If we select you as competitive for the Fellowship scheme, we will help you with your application which has a deadline of 16 March 2023.

If successful with your application to NIHR, you will be given a salaried position at the University of York for the duration of the award and the opportunity to:

- Undertake a master's degree in health economics (fully funded at UK student rates) unless you already have one.
- Work on supervised research projects and have additional training in CHE.
