# WHAT IS THE UK-JIANGSU WORLD-CLASS UNIVERSITIES CONSORTIUM (UKJS)?

Jiangsu Province is located on the east coast of China, just north of Shanghai. It is one of the most populous and prosperous provinces in China.

Jointly spearheaded by the British Council, Universities UK, and the Jiangsu Provincial Department of Education, UKJS is a consortium of 32 universities from Jiangsu Province and 16 universities from the UK (see membership list on page 4). York is a founder member. The Consortium draws its impetus from the Chinese government's 'World-Class Universities' and 'First-Class Disciplines' initiative, which seeks to develop several of its institutions into world-class universities by 2020.

Considered as a blueprint for UK-China university cooperation, the Consortium hopes to encourage **many-to-many links** between UK and Jiangsu members in the research areas of **advanced manufacturing**, **environmental engineering**, and **health**.

#### **Objectives:**

- To build a platform that will deepen and broaden the level of strategic engagement and collaboration between universities in the UK and Jiangsu
- To raise the profile of the Jiangsu higher education sector in the UK and of the UK higher education sector in Jiangsu
- To harness multilateral cooperation as a mechanism to raise the quality and competitiveness of the participating institutions; sharing opportunities and addressing shared challenges together

# HOW CAN YOU GET INVOLVED?

- Host a visiting Post Graduate Researcher (PGR) or Early Career Researcher (ECR) from the Province (more information below)
- Apply for seed funding, which is available on a rolling basis for research projects and academic workshops that involve at least two-UK and two-Jiangsu partners

# VISITING RESEARCHERS PROGRAMME

As part of the Consortium, the Jiangsu Province Department of Education (JPDE) will fund between 95-130 PGRs and ECRs to visit UK-Member Universities each year, for the next five years. It is hoped that this will encourage the building of research links in the Consortium.

# FUNDING

Funding will be £8,000 for a 6-month PhD placement, and £16,000 for a one-year ECR placement. This funding includes a £1,600/ £3,200 bench fee (non-negotiable). The remainder of the funding is for the visitor's accommodation and living costs. Funding for reasonable expense costs such as materials and equipment will be considered on a case by case basis.

# TIMELINE

JANUARY	Register your interest as soon as possible to host a visiting researcher in the Academic Year 20-21
FEBRUARY	An anonymized list of potential UK hosts to be shared with partner universities in Jiangsu Province
MARCH	ECRs and PGRs apply to preferred hosts, based on compatibility of research interests
APRIL	Global Partnerships Officer to notify potential York hosts who receive applications. Potential York host to consider applications and interview candidates
APRIL ONWARDS	Normal departmental policies and procedures for accepting visiting researchers to be followed
SEPT ONWARDS	Visitors arrive
