This essay will provide an outline of one physical or mental health condition. Discuss one commonly used clinical guideline for that condition, briefly outline the pathophysiology of the condition, and highlight the potential needs of a patient/client. Discuss the role and responsibilities of the Nursing Associate in contributing to meeting the care needs of a patient/client in relation to the chosen guideline.

Assessment Guidance

- Provide an outline of the chosen condition and the underlying pathophysiology of the condition.
- Outline the key physical, psychological, social, and cultural needs a patient/client with this condition may experience.
- Discuss one commonly used clinical guideline associated with the condition.
- In implementing the clinical guideline chosen, consider your role and responsibilities as a Nursing Associate in meeting the care needs of a patient/client; including responding to changes and escalating concerns (NMC, 2018).
- Your discussion must be informed by relevant literature and policy.
