<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● An outline of the team you will write about, including its leadership ● A critical evaluation of the ways in which leadership, supervision and teamwork is effective. ● An analysis of the barriers that may prevent effective teamwork and supervision. ● A summary of the key points discussed and the conclusions reached, including how this might inform your future practice as a Nurse Associate.
