<b>Assessment Guidance</b>			
<u>Formative Assessment</u>			
The formative assessment for this module will require you to focus on an area of midwifery practice in relation to postnatal care and the module learning outcomes and/content. You will need to form an answerable question and demonstrate your ability to search for research evidence to support midwifery practice.			
Your formative assessment will need to include details of how you accessed your resources, effectively utilised the relevant databases, used and understood the Harvard referencing system and include strategies to aid and develop your searching techniques. The formative assessment can be presented as a short report.

<u>Summative Assessment</u>			
The summative assessment for this module is an essay. The aim of the essay is for you to identify a topic from the module learning outcomes and module content to consider as a focus for your essay.			
You will need to ensure that you include the following in your essay:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Identify a chosen topic and rationale for your essay.</li> <li>• Identify your answerable question (from your formative assessment).</li> <li>• Demonstrate knowledge from the bio-psycho-social sciences that will facilitate the provision of safe and sensitive, women-centred care or care of the neonate.</li> <li>• Consider the relevant available evidence in relation to your chosen postnatal topic.</li> <li>• Incorporate any relevant midwifery skills or procedures required to support your chosen topic.</li> <li>• Consider the roles and responsibilities of the midwife in relation to your chosen topic.</li> </ul>
