You are required to critically analyse your communication skills. You should also include feedback from others relevant to the scenario, and explore the value and limitations of feedback as a learning tool. You must apply appropriate theory and research findings to your reflection.</p> <p>You should draw conclusions from your learning, identifying actions which will support future development of your interpersonal and communication skills with colleagues, women and/or their families (as relevant).</p> <p>Relevant and appropriately referenced source material should be included in your essay, referenced according to Department guidelines.</p>
