Assessment Guidance

Assessment Title

Oral in person presentation on perceptions of health and wellbeing:

“Health is a state of complete physical, mental and social well-being and not merely the absence of disease or infirmity” (WHO 1948, page 1).

In relation to this quote, explain your understanding of health to your peers. Use key psychological /sociological theory to support your argument.

Assessment Guidance

10-minute oral in person presentation (PowerPoint - maximum of 5 slides + 1 for references).

- Add an introductory slide with your name, the title of the assessment and a brief introduction to your presentation
- Discuss your understanding of the concept of health in relation to the WHO (1948) definition.
- Use one slide to explain health in relation to psychological theory and outline the key points supported by relevant literature.
- Use one slide to explain health in relation to sociological theory and outline the key points supported by relevant literature
- Conclude your presentation by outlining how your understanding of the WHO definition of health has changed.

Summative in person Powerpoint presentation

Please submit your presentation following the guidance from the assessment office by the stipulated date and time which will be prior to the in person presentation. If you do not submit your presentation paperwork by the published date your overall module mark will be subject to standard University penalties for late submission of assessments.
