This is the health numeracy assessment in the form of medicines calculations required by the NMC (2018 – <a href="#">Part 3: Standards for pre-registration nursing programmes</a>, section 4: Supervision and assessment, sub-section 4.6). You are required to complete the unseen medicines calculation test and obtain a score of 100% in order to pass.</p> <p>The assessment is an examination which will be available for 24 hours. You should aim to spend 60 minutes on this exam.</p> <p><u>Formative support</u>            To assist you in developing your knowledge, you will work through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use safeMedicate to develop medicines calculations skills and undertake formative assessments during the programme.</li> <li>• Sample questions.</li> <li>• Support to develop technique in calculating dosages for prescribed medicines to answer exam questions.</li> </ul>
