Assessment Guidance

Part 1 - OSCE

You are required to complete your OSCE through consideration of the following:

- Begin the OSCE by taking a focused history relevant to the complaint
- Perform the relevant physical/mental health examination
- Consider differential diagnoses and formulate a plan of care

Part 2 - Professional discussion

Following completion of the OSCE, you will participate in a professional discussion in which you will be asked questions about your OSCE

Formative support

To assist you in developing your OSCE, you will have opportunity to:

- Participate in skills practice and receive feedback from your peers and seminar lead
- Interview and be interviewed by your peers, with input / feedback from your seminar lead, to prepare for the summative professional discussion
