<i>Formative assessment</i>			
You will write a 500 word critique of a research paper which considers a diagnostic test			
<i>Summative assessment</i>			
You will write an essay of up to 3000 words (+/- 10%) where you will critically consider the evidence base which underpinned a decision that you made which related to patient care.			
As a minimum the essay should include:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • brief overview of what the decision was • critical consideration of the decision-making process including reference to theory • critical consideration of the evidence that you drew on to make the decision (including patient data, research, policies etc.) • synthesis of the evidence to conclude your decision and direct your management
