<p>Assessment Guidance</p> <p><u>Formative Assessment</u> You are invited to submit an annotated bibliography of 1,000 words (maximum) relating to your summative assignment (essay).</p> <p>Your annotated bibliography can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Core references for your proposed summative essay assignment including notes/comments on the main arguments/issues each reference will provide. • A proposed essay structure/headings and sub-headings with core references in each section <p><u>Summative Assessment</u> You are required to submit an essay on the ethical, methodological, logistical and political challenges in conducting an evaluation in a selected humanitarian situation.</p> <p>Select a humanitarian crisis as a case study and a thematic area/programme such as, but not limited to, food and nutrition; shelter; water, sanitation and hygiene; health; and protection. You are advised to use ReliefWeb and ALNAP repositories of actual evaluation reports for your case study and thematic area.</p> <p>Your essay should include an introduction presenting your case study and thematic area and also any limitations to the essay. Your essay should demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the core concepts and critical debates that have been presented and explored throughout the module, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The contemporary dilemmas and challenges of humanitarian evaluations • The impact and ethical, methodological, logistical and political issues and challenges of evaluations and how these impact and relate to each other. <p>References should be used throughout your assignment.</p>
