### **Assessment Guidance**

#### Part 1 - OAR Completion

You and your Practice Assessor should meet to evaluate your achievement of the required summative outcomes.

To pass the placement you must have met each of the following criteria by the end of the scheduled placement or by the end of the automatic extension period of 4 weeks through a summative Action Plan:

- 1. A summatively assessed Episode of Care with your Practice Assessor
- 2. Professional Values outcomes
- 3. Verification of having met the Stage Proficiencies
- 4. Practice Assessor verification of your record of achievement
- 5. Medicines management outcomes
- 6. Ensuring that your E-OAR will be completed by the submission date on the assessment schedule.

#### Part 2 - Closed Exam

You will sit a closed online exam assessing your competence in medicines management numeracy using the safeMedicate platform.

This is part of the health numeracy assessment required by the NMC (2018 – Part 3: Standards for pre-registration nursing programmes, section 4: Supervision and assessment, sub-section 4.6).

You are required to complete the unseen medicines calculation assessment and obtain a score of 100% in order to pass.

You should check your access to, and be familiar with, the safeMedicate platform in advance of the exam.
