Assessment Guidance

Assessment Title

Clinical decisions based on evidence are essential to nursing and healthcare practice. You are asked to produce an academic poster in PowerPoint presenting how evidence-based decision making is used in your practice.

Assessment Guidance

You will deliver a 15-minute poster presentation to a group of your peers. In your presentation you are required to:

- Formulate an answerable question related to a selected treatment or clinical practice using an appropriate question formulation tool.
- Describe your approach to searching the available literature and report the results of our search in a systematic way in line with established reporting methods.
- Appraise the quality of the literature included as a result of your literature search.
- Discuss how the literature findings help to answer your question, identifying any gaps in the evidence and the implications of this for your evidence-based practice.
- Discuss how factors important in evidence-based nursing inform your decision making in practice.

This will be followed by 1-2 questions about your presentation from your examiners.

- Discuss the plan for your presentation with a member of the module team.
- Practice delivering your presentation with your peer group.
