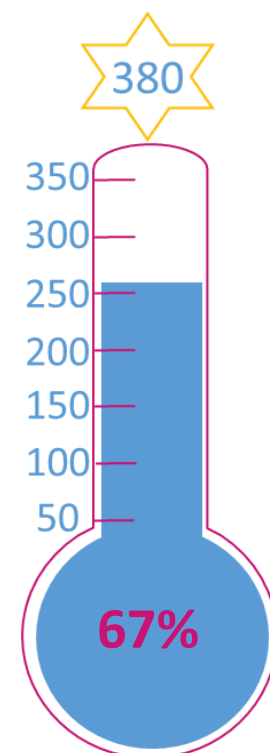

# Final 12 months of recruitment

## Recruitment update

- 255 participants have been recruited!
- 125 participants to go until we meet our target
- Behind monthly targets for May (6) and June (6)
- We have 37 open to recruitment so if every site recruits another 5 participants in the next 12 months we will have reached our target.



## Screening & Randomisation

- Please continue to return your **Screening logs** to York Trials Unit (YTU) on a monthly basis.
- If you have any issues with randomisation, please contact the YTU team immediately .

## Outstanding documents

- As part of our annual checks we review any outstanding documents we expect to be sent from sites for recruited patients.
- We need these for central monitoring and for sending out CRFs to home addresses.
- Please prioritise outstanding consent and contact details forms. Please ensure CRFs are posted back to us as soon as possible once completed.
