



- **Monthly target of 10 recruits**



Site Investigator Meeting

Thank you to those who were able to attend our Site Investigator meetings last month. We have outlined some key topics that were discussed.

Patient Equipoise

- Emphasise the evidence that individuals who are recruited to clinical trials tend to have better outcomes, and whatever treatment they are allocated to, they will get the best care.
- Explain the process of randomisation clearly
- Research team members can sign up to the GRANULE e-learning course hosted by the NIHR to learn how to communicate effectively to patients about clinical trials

Screening

- Patients come through multiple pathways and early identification if key
- Developing a site appropriate regular screening routine is crucial
- Good relationships with other departments is important so that they can direct potential participants to the P2 research team
- The API scheme, clinic posters, and the Emergency Department card can all support screening and recruitment at sites

We are now requesting screening logs to be returned to the YTU on a monthly basis
