Part-time students follow the course over two years, starting on Monday September 29th 2014, with the dissertation due in the 50th week of the second year of enrolment. Induction and training sessions are held throughout the first year to introduce the library and scholarly bibliographic and on-line resources. The core Research Skills in History of Art course is taken by part-time students in their first and fifth terms. Students also choose four option modules. In most cases, part-time students take one option module in each of the Autumn and Spring Terms during their two years of enrolment, but this can be flexible. An introductory module, Theory and Historiography, will be available in the Autumn Term for those who have not studied art history before. Apart from the History of Art options, modules are available from the Centres for Medieval, Renaissance and Early Modern, Eighteenth Century, and Modern Studies, and in the departments of Archaeology, English, and History. The summer terms and vacations of both years should be devoted to researching and writing the dissertation under the guidance of an appropriate supervisor.
