

The conference York 1190: Jews and others in the wake of massacre was held in York 22-24 March 2010. It was attended by 83 participants drawn from a wide range of academic disciplines from across the UK, Europe, the US and Israel, and by members of the public with an interest in Jewish history. New themes raised in the conference included much new work on narratives influencing and memorializing 1190 and new evidence from local and other archives concerning relations between Jews and others in the period.

The conference began with a tribute to Professor Barrie Dobson and his seminal work on the Jews of York and of England, including the presentation of a new collection of his essays on medieval Anglo-Jewry. The conference finished with two performances by a combined student drama group from the Universities of Oxford and York.
