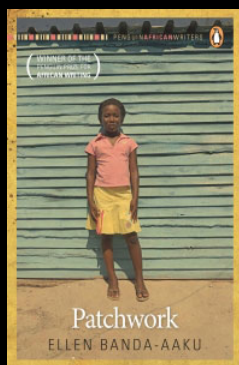


# Black History Month 2011
