Travel and Directions

The event will be held in the Research Centre for Social Sciences (RCSS) www.york.ac.uk/social-science This is a forty-five minute walk from the train station, but easily accessible by both taxi and bus from the station (around ten and twenty minutes respectively – although journeys sometimes take up to 45 minutes at peak travel times). A taxi will usually cost around £6 and a bus around £1.50.
