FLOOR PLAN: SPRING LANE BUILDING **W**

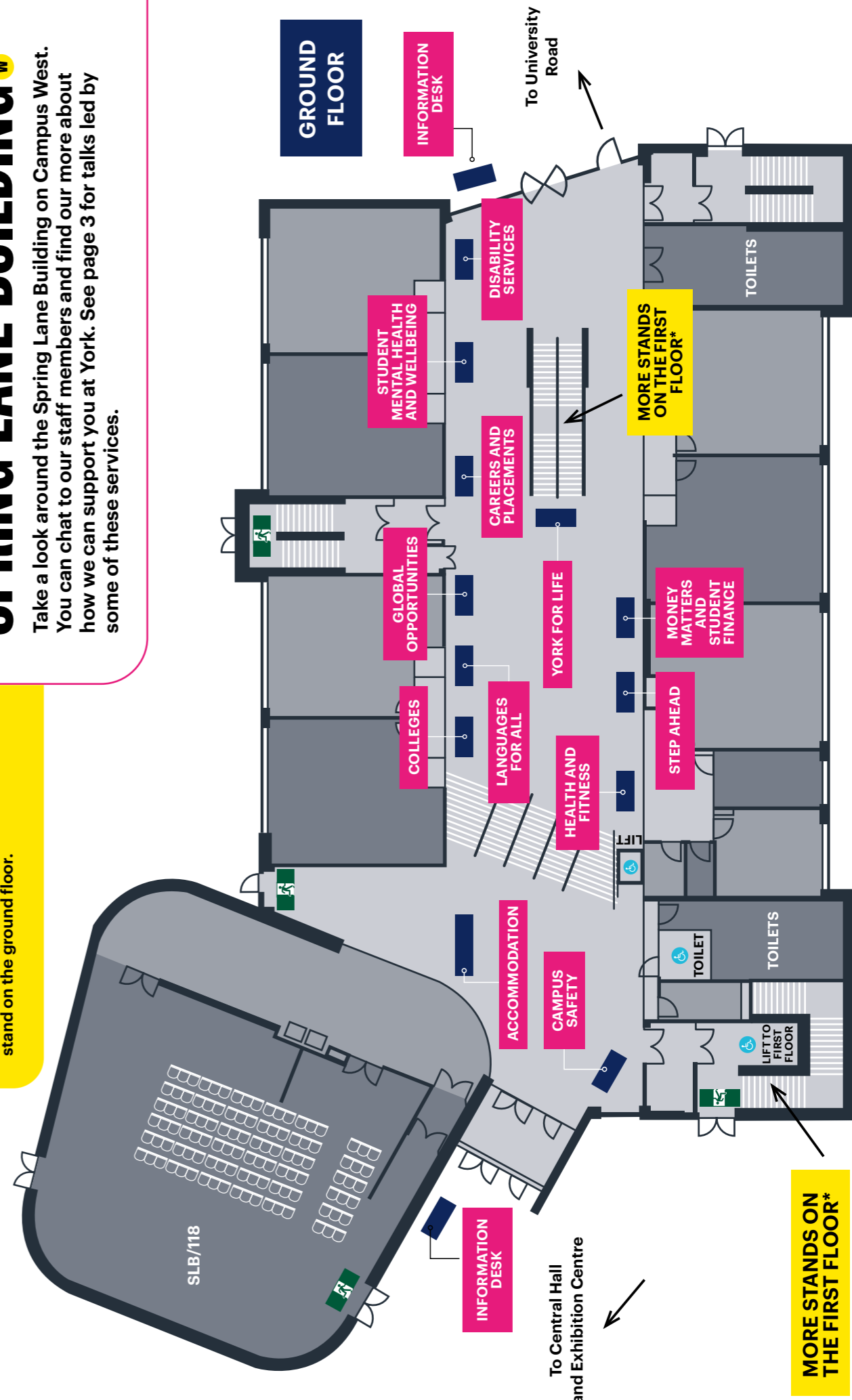

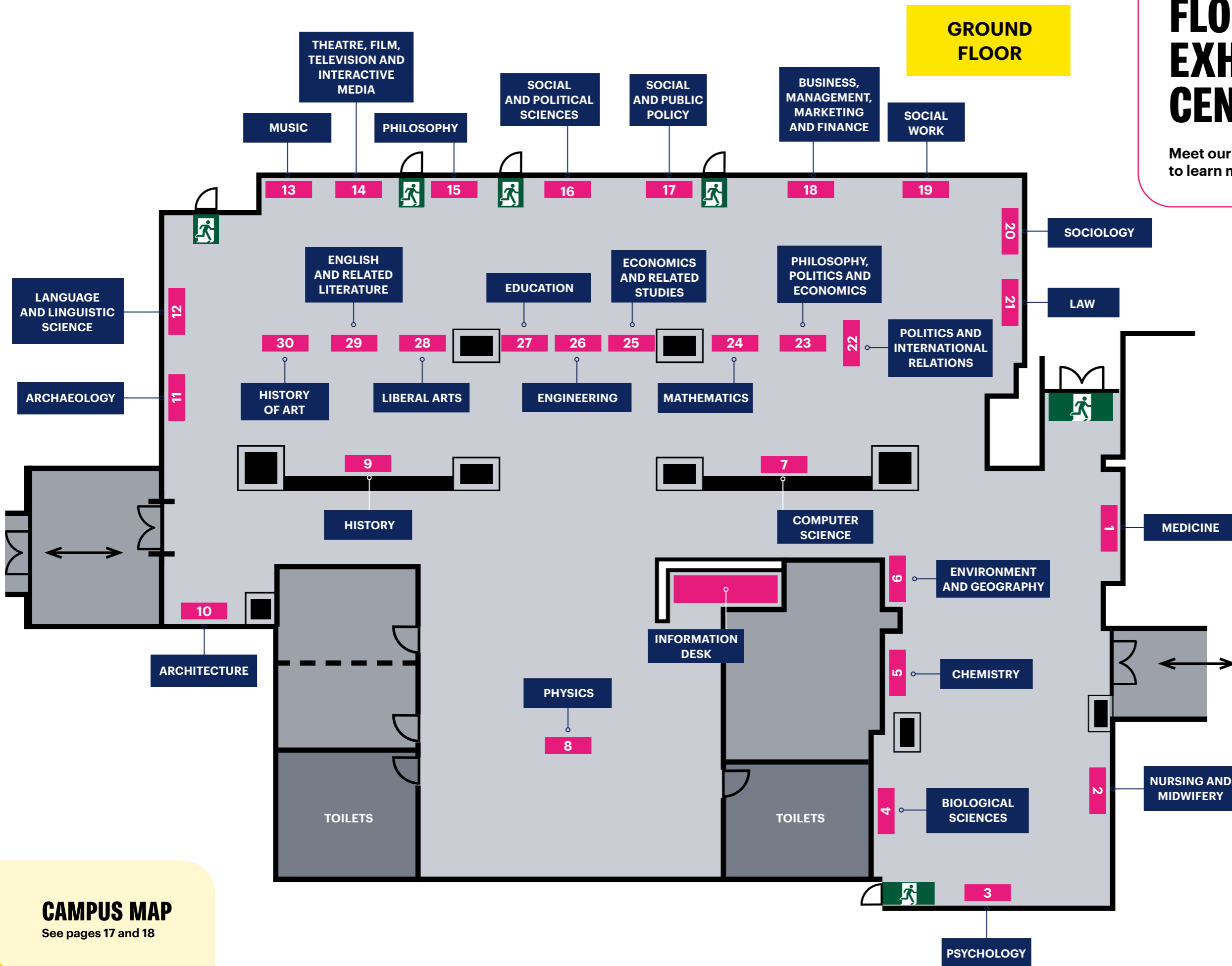
