Abstract:

The biosphere is a stupendously complex and poorly understood system, which we depend on for our survival, and which we are attacking on every front. Worrying. But what has that got to do with Machine Learning and AI? After outlining some of the ways in which ML and AI could transform our ability to manage and protect Nature (Nature needs AI), I will shift to discussing the less orthodox idea that progress in AI depends on an understanding of Nature (AI needs Nature). In particular, I will argue that simulations of ecological tasks in naturalistic environments could be an important test bed for developing AI.
