The TRANSIT Process: experiences in cross-disciplinary and co-creation in research

Abstract:

We will give an overview of the three stage TRANSIT process for promoting and deepening interdisciplinary research that was developed within YCCSA, originally supported by an EPSRC Bridging the Gaps award. We will give examples of past and current activities, and reflect on both successes and failures and how these have influenced the shape and culture of interdisciplinary research in YCCSA and beyond. We will share some ideas about more intentional research on how to promote effective interdisciplinary interactions, and open up discussion with the audience about possible ways to improve our understanding of cross-disciplinary working.
